

Minutes
VRASC Meeting
December 9, 2005

Meeting held at the Los Angeles Police Historical Society Museum

1. Minutes were approved from the Spring 2005 meeting, held at the Getty Research Institute.
2. Treasurer's Report: The business meeting began with a reading of the Treasurer's report by Jennifer Johnson. After the \$100 donation to the LAPHS made at the December 9th meeting, funds were low in the account. It was announced that memberships were due, and if membership funds came in a surplus would exist, allowing the SC/VRA chapter to offer a National Conference scholarship in the Spring.
2. Webmaster: A call was made for a new Webmaster for the chapter website. When no volunteer came forward, it was suggested that we consider a member-at-large, or non-VRA chapter member, to maintain the website. There was no much support for this idea. Krista Coquia volunteered to update the site, and to redesign the website to make maintenance easier. Jackie Spafford will continue to host the site at UC Santa Barbara.
3. Elections: It was announced that terms for the Chairperson and Treasurer expired at the end of 2005, and elections needed to be held as soon as possible. Volunteers were called to form a three-person nominating committee. Loy Zimmerman, Jane Glicksman, and Krista Coquia stepped forward and formed the committee.
