

**Visual Resources Curator, Department of Art and Design, East Tennessee State University, Johnson City, TN**

The Department of Art and Design at East Tennessee State University seeks a full-time curator to manage and develop its visual resources collection of slides and digital images, beginning July 1, 2008. The curator is responsible for the overall management of the collection of approximately 100,000 slides and a growing collection of 60,000+ digital images. The curator will facilitate the continuing conversion of the collection to digital format. Duties include the production, acquisition, cataloging, circulation, conservation, and maintenance of the collection, including the use and maintenance of equipment, in support of the undergraduate and graduate programs in the Department of Art and Design. The curator also is responsible for the supervision of personnel hiring, training and evaluation of student workers.

**Requirements:**

Degree in Art or Art History or related field and minimum three years of relevant work experience. Master's degree preferred. Solid knowledge of art history and demonstrated knowledge of visual resources cataloging practices required. Applicant must be skilled in the use of photographic slide production, digital imaging technology, Adobe PhotoShop, image databases, and cataloging software. Excellent interpersonal skills and ability to work well with faculty, staff and students are essential.

The application should include the following: 1) letter of intent describing background and experience; 2) curriculum vitae; 3) names and contact information of three references.
