

The University Libraries, of the University of South Dakota, invites applications for a new position, Metadata and Cataloging Librarian. (Rank-Assistant Professor)

For this position, the University of South Dakota (USD) seeks a collaborative, user-focused librarian dedicated to providing access to digital collections through metadata creation, and traditional collections through original and complex cataloging. The librarian will participate in the ongoing development of the Digital Library of South Dakota <http://dlsd.sdln.net/>, a recently-established, statewide endeavor, as well as in implementing an institutional repository at USD. As a member of the University Libraries faculty, the selected candidate will be expected to excel in librarianship, serve as a liaison to an academic department, provide reference and information services, and engage in service to the profession. The position reports to the Archives and Special Collections Librarian.

Minimum Qualifications: Master's degree in Library Science or Information Science from an ALA-accredited program; undergraduate major or concentration within the fine arts, humanities, natural sciences, or physical sciences; demonstrated experience in using CONTENTdm or other digital library software applications; professional understanding and experience with non-MARC metadata schemas and standards such as, but not limited to, DCMI; professional understanding and experience with cataloging procedures and standards such as, but not limited to, AACR2 rev., LCSH and LC classification, OCLC-MARC, and authority formats; knowledge of emerging cataloging developments such as RDA and FRBR; excellent writing skills; ability to work respectfully and effectively with diverse constituents; demonstrated experience in working independently, problem-solving and project management; teaching ability; attention to detail; evidence of professional involvement within academic librarianship; and the ability to adapt to and contribute to a changing organizational environment.

Desirable Qualifications: Three years of professional experience in an academic library or equivalent experience; advanced degree in fine arts, humanities, natural sciences, or physical sciences; reading ability in at least one European language; knowledge of DACS, EAD, DCRM, VRA Core, AAT, and TGM; and an aptitude for developing web-based applications for CONTENTdm.
