

## Curator of Visual Resources

Indiana University of Pennsylvania is seeking a Curator of Visual Resources in the Department of Art. This is a full-time temporary position (8/28/2010 - 6/3/2011) at the rank of Assistant Professor. The Curator will serve as the primary administrator for the visual resources collection. Primary responsibilities include collection development and management for the three departments within the College of Fine Arts (Art, Music and Theatre); hiring and training of student assistants and interns; design and creation of digital interactive teaching tools; liaison with Visual Resources Committee, the University Museum, and University Libraries. The Curator is expected to be active in professional organizations such as VRA and ARLIS. Additional responsibilities include ¼ load teaching duties. Teaching assignments will be made with respect to a candidate's background and areas of competency.

Minimum qualifications: Ph.D. in Art History and two years' experience in university visual resources collection preferred. Master's of Library Science degrees with a B.A. in Art History will also be considered. Leadership, communication, organizational, and grant-writing skills essential. Reading knowledge of two or more languages desired.
